5. Eligibility

- a. The citizen of Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan or Turkmenistan
- b. Currently enrolled in the second to fourth academic year as an undergraduate student who is majoring Business, Commerce, Economics or Finance at a university located in one of the 5 (five) Central Asian countries
- c. Total grade point average 70% or higher
- d. Fluent in English
- e. Mentally and physically healthy
- f. Have interest and willingness to adapt in Korean culture and life

c. How to Nominate

- ① Electronically submit a list of nominated students and their required documents in a PDF format – ‘one file for each student’ (*PDF file name: a student’s name in capital letters)
- ② If our university finishes document screening, the nominated students will be invited for an interview. The interview will be conducted by phone or through imo, etc.
- ③ Submit original application documents via courier to Keimyung University
(* The submission due date will be informed soon.)

7. Required documents

- ① Completed application forms
 - ② A copy of passport information page (*Applicant should prepare an international passport before the original document submission by his/her home university.)
 - ③ Certificate of Enrollment in English issued by a home university
 - ④ Officially sealed academic transcript in English issued by a home university
 - ⑤ Self-Introduction and Research Plan
 - ⑥ A Letter of Recommendation from Dean of Faculty or Head of Department of a home university
 - ⑦ Official English proficiency test transcript (if applicable)
- ※ Note: Additional documents may be required.
- ※ ①, ⑤ and ⑥ you should use the provided forms.

8. Benefits for Program Participants

- a. NIIED (National Institute for International Education under the Ministry of Education) will be responsible for an international round trip air ticket, room and board during the duration of this program, and traveler’s insurance.
- b. Participants will be responsible for the expenses during a program such as local transportation, visa fee, etc.
